

MINUTES OF AN ONLINE EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK, TEXAS, HELD VIA VIDEOCONFERENCE, AT 8:00 A.M ON FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2020.

Gayle Kirby, Town Secretary, explained that as provided by the State of Texas, this online Emergency Town Council meeting could be viewed online or listened to by telephone, and gave the toll-free and alternate telephone numbers and the access code for citizens to call. Ms. Kirby conducted a roll call of the Town Council Members. Present at the meeting were Mayor Margo Goodwin, Mayor Pro Tem David Dowler, and Town Council Members Jimmy Grisham, Marc Myers, Lydia Novakov, and Craig Penfold.

Mayor Goodwin introduced herself, and called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m.

Mayor Goodwin recessed the emergency Town Council meeting at 8:05 a.m. and convened a closed session pursuant to Section 551.076 of the Texas Government Code to deliberate the deployment of security personnel and devices relating to possible civil disturbances and rioting in Town Limits.

Mayor Goodwin closed the closed session at 8:53 a.m. and reconvened the emergency Town Council meeting in open session. No final action, decision, or vote was taken during the closed session.

On a motion by Council Member Penfold, seconded by Council Member Myers, the Town Council voted unanimously to extend the Mayor's Declaration of Local Disaster, set to expire at 6:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 7, 2020, for fourteen days, and adopt associated regulations related to possible civil disturbances and rioting in Town Limits. Prior to the vote, in response to questions from Mayor Goodwin, Matthew Boyle, Town Attorney, explained that the Declaration of Local Disaster is posted on the Town's bulletin boards, on its website, and is filed in the office of the Town Secretary; an emphasis on clarity will be implemented in staff publications.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 8:59 a.m.


