

RESOLUTION NO. 006-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK, TEXAS, REAPPOINTING GARY A. SLAGEL TO THE AGGREGATED POSITION OF REPRESENTATIVE TO THE DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS, WHICH FRACTIONAL ALLOCATION MEMBERSHIP IS SHARED WITH THE CITY OF RICHARDSON, THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, AND THE TOWN OF ADDISON; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 452.573 of the Texas Transportation Code authorizes cities having a fractional allocation for board membership to aggregate their populations in order to appoint a member of the board of the rapid transit authority; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Highland Park, the City of Richardson, the City of University Park, and the Town of Addison have mutually agreed to aggregate their populations for the selection of a Dallas Area Rapid Transit Authority ("DART") Board Member; and

WHEREAS, Gary A. Slagel has served as the Town's representative on the DART Board of Directors since November of 2011;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That, the Town of Highland Park hereby reappoints Gary A. Slagel as its representative for the DART Board of Directors to serve a two-year term ending July 1, 2022.

SECTION 2. That, the City of Richardson, the City of University Park, and the Town of Addison having concurred, the Town of Highland Park, Texas, hereby reappoints Gary A. Slagel to serve on the DART Board of Directors in the aggregated position for the term ending July 1, 2022.

SECTION 3. That, this resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
