## OVERVIEW

As of May 31, 2022, General and Utility Fund combined revenues are \$30,665,311. This is 80.5% of the annual budgeted amounts.

Combined expenses and encumbrances of \$26,055,677 are 67.3% of the annual budget. May 31st marks the eighth month of the FY 2022 Budget Year. Therefore, the year to date budget percentage for budgetary comparison is 66.7%.

## YEAR TO DATE OVERVIEW

Through May 31st, General Fund non-property tax revenues of \$9,075,101 are \$1,979,802 more than originally projected. Total revenues (including Property Taxes) are \$2,006,981 more than projected and are up 6.6% compared to the same period in the prior fiscal year.

## PROPERTY TAXES

Tax collections of \$15,348,047 year to date have been received. Year to date, 99.0% of the annual budget has been collected. In the prior fiscal year 101.0% had been collected at this time.

## SALES TAXES

Total revenues of \$4,647,311 are \$1,724,906 more than projected year to date. Current year revenue is \$1,220,814 more than this time last year.

## MIXED BEVERAGE TAXES

Mixed Beverage Tax receipts of \$307,926 are \$63,000 more than projected for this time of the year and \$40,841 more than this time last year. Mixed Beverage Taxes are received monthly.

## FRANCHISE FEES

Franchise Fees total \$825,621 which is \$61,037 more than projected and up \$71,414 when compared to the amount received during the same period in the prior fiscal year. Franchise Fees are received monthly and quarterly with the exception of the Natural Gas franchise fee, which is one-time payment received each year in the month of February.

## LICENSES AND PERMITS

Revenues of \$1,059,017 are \$275,784 more than projected year to date, and are (\$59,748) less than the amount received prior year to date. Licenses and permits accounts primarily for building permits, but also includes electrical and alarm permits as well as beverage and carriage service licenses. In November 2020, revenue included \$275,000 related to the Dallas County Club fitness center and parking garage.

## CHARGES FOR SERVICES

Revenues of \$896,222 are (\$185,398) less than projected year to date. Revenues are more than the previous fiscal year by \$25,980.

## FINES AND FORFEITURES

Total revenues of \$190,920 are (\$129,550) less than projected through the end of May and \$42,152 more than the same period in the prior fiscal year.

## EARNINGS ON INVESTMENTS

Interest earnings of \$39,483 are (\$1,695) less than projected.

## MISCELLANEOUS REVENUES

Total revenues of \$468,601 are up \$171,718 from the amount projected through May. Miscellaneous revenues include penalties on delinquent property taxes, tower lease rental charges, donations, contributions, and other non-major revenues. The increase is primarily related to the donation of \$110,000 received from the Highland Park Quality of Life Foundation.

## TRANSFERS

Biannual transfers consist of a reimbursement from the Utility Fund for the fund's share of G&A expenses and a transfer from the Court Security Fund to reimburse the General Fund for payroll related costs associated with the court bailiff.

# GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES

## YEAR TO DATE OVERVIEW

May 31, 2022, marks the eighth month of the FY 2022 budget year. The year to date budget percentage for budgetary comparison is therefore 66.7%. Total General Fund expenditures and encumbrances of \$19,243,369 are 68.7% of the annual budget.

## ADMINISTRATION

Administration has expended and encumbered 64.0% of the departmental budget or \$498,444.

## PUBLIC SAFETY

Public Safety expended and encumbered 65.9% of the departmental budget or \$9,151,359.

## DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Development Services expended and encumbered 59.7% of the departmental budget or \$194,357.

## PARKS

Parks has expended and encumbered \$1,267,424 or 74.4% of the departmental budget.

## FINANCE

Finance has expended and encumbered \$618,289 or 64.4% of the departmental budget.

## BUILDING INSPECTION

Building Inspection has expended and encumbered \$458,827 or 57.9% of the departmental budget.

## NON-DEPARTMENTAL

Non-Departmental has expended and encumbered \$464,066 or 86.4% of the departmental budget.


## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Information Technology has expended and encumbered \$606,365 or 82.4% of the departmental budget.

## TRANSFERS

Biannual transfers include a transfer to the CIP Fund for infrastructure maintenance / rehabilitation. Transfers to the Equipment and Technology Replacement Funds accumulate resources for future equipment and technology purchases. A transfer to the Building Maintenance Fund supports the operational and maintenance budgets of Town Hall and the Service Center. Transfers to the Internal Service Funds occur once a year in January.

## YEAR TO DATE OVERVIEW

Total Utility Fund operational revenues (excluding transfers) of \$6,060,013 are \$21,369 more than projected year to date and are up 4.3% when compared to the amount received through the same period in the prior year.

## WATER SALES

Revenues totaling \$4,095,958 are \$44,504 more than projected year to date. Water sales are up about \$265,439 when compared to the amount of revenue generated during the same period last year.

## SEWER CHARGES

Revenues of \$1,805,819 are (\$42,556) less than projected through the end of May. Revenues for sanitary sewer are down (1.0%) or (\$17,849) when compared to this same period for the previous fiscal year. Sanitary sewer billings are driven by water consumption.

## OTHER CHARGES FOR SERVICES

Year to date revenues of \$32,436 are \$1,599 more than projected. This revenue source is primarily driven by charges for meter installations.

## LICENSES AND PERMITS

Licenses and permits revenue (i.e. Plumbing Permits) of \$41,625 or (\$571) less than projected and (\$3,540) less than the amount received through the same period of the prior fiscal year.

## FINES AND FORFEITURES

Revenues (penalties assessed on past due utility bills) of \$40,910 are \$5,947 more than the year to date projection. Late payment penalty revenue is driven by payment timing and the size of the past due balance.

## EARNINGS ON INVESTMENTS

Interest earnings are \$28,971 and (\$515) below projection.

## MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE

Miscellaneous Revenue accounts for contributions, cost sharing related to repairs, maintenance, and capital projects from outside organizations.

## TRANSFERS

Biannual transfers consist of a transfer from the Solid Waste Fund for reimbursement of the Solid Waste Fund's share of Utility Fund admin costs. Additionally, transfers from the Capital Project and Storm Water Drainage Funds offset related Engineering services.

## OVERVIEW

May 31, 2022, marks the eighth month of FY 2022 budget year. The year to date budget percentage for budgetary comparison is therefore 66.7%. Year to date expenditures, plus encumbrances and less non-cash expenditures of depreciation and bad debts, total \$6,812,308 or 63.7% of annual budget.

## UTILITY ADMINISTRATION

The Utility Administration budget expended and encumbered is \$412,462 which represents 81.6% of the departmental operating budget.

## WATER

At \$3,614,298 the Water Department has expended and encumbered 67.8% of the annual budget amount and includes \$1,632,594 related to capital improvements.

## SEWER

At \$1,352,280 the Sewer Department has expended and encumbered 60.2% of the annual budget amount, of which \$351,375 relate to capital improvements.


## ENGINEERING

The Engineering budget expended and encumbered \$408,772 which represents 59.0% of the departmental operating budget.

## TRANSFERS

Biannual transfers to other funds include a transfer to the General Fund for the Utility Fund's share of General Fund G&A expenses and a transfer to the CIP Fund based on 5% of water and sanitary sewer revenues. A transfer to the Building Maintenance Fund is made for the Utility Fund's share of building maintenance expenditures, and a transfer to the Equipment and Technology Replacement Funds is made to fund future equipment and technology purchases. Total transfers to the Internal Service Funds occur once a year, in the month of January.

- (1) Working Capital is defined as current assets less current liabilities. The Working Capital totals have not been reduced by outstanding encumbrances because expenditures are recognized in the period the liability is incurred. As May 31, 2022, the Town had a total of \$10,796,935 in outstanding encumbrances.
- (2) Dedicated funds represent the amount of Working Capital that has been reserved to comply with financial management policies, special purpose, or lawful requirements.
- (3) Available Working Capital is the amount of Working Capital in excess of dedicated funds.
- (4) The Reserve Fund holds proceeds from land sales completed by the Town.

# CASH AND INVESTMENTS

The market value of the Town's investment portfolio at May 31, 2022 was \$56,438,202. This amount is 100.00% of the recorded book value of \$56,438,202. The Town's investment practice is to invest funds for specific maturity or call dates (passive investment management), rather than buy and sell based upon market conditions (active investment management). The total portfolio yield is .73%.





