

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK, TEXAS, HELD AT THE TOWN HALL, 4700 DREXEL DRIVE, HIGHLAND PARK, TX, 75205, AT 8:00 A.M. ON TUESDAY, JUNE 20, 2023.

Present at the meeting were Mayor Will C. Beecherl, Mayor Pro Tem Craig Penfold, and Town Council Members Lydia Novakov, Don Snell, and Marc Myers. Absent from the meeting was Town Council Member Leland White.

Mayor Beecherl introduced himself, called the meeting to order at 8:01 a.m., and gave the Invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA



Mayor Beecherl adjourned the Town Council meeting at 8:07 a.m.


