HPDPS is Requesting Public's Assistance to Identify Theft Suspects

November 30, 2017 (Highland Park, Texas) – Highland Park DPS is actively searching for the two suspects responsible for a recent package theft in Highland Park. The theft offense took place in broad daylight in the 3600 block of Beverly Drive on November 26th at around 11:55 a.m. in the morning. Based on review of video evidence, the two suspects worked in tandem to commit the theft: suspect #1 approached the home from the sidewalk on foot and removed the package while suspect #2 followed close behind and positioned the vehicle he was driving in a manner that would provide concealment of the theft. After stealing the package from the front porch, suspect #1 handed off the package to suspect #2, and both suspects can be seen leaving the property in the suspect vehicle west bound on Beverly Drive.

Suspect #1 is described as a white female, between 30 and 40 years in age, approximately 5'4, trim build, dark colored zip-up jacket w/ hood, dark colored shirt, blue jeans, and wearing eyeglasses. Suspect #2 is described as a white male, between 25 and 35 years in age, trim facial features, clean shaven, white t-shirt, and wearing sunglasses. The suspect vehicle is possibly a 2013 or similar year model Honda Accord sedan, grey in color, with factory wheels.
