Public Hearing of Re-Accreditation for Highland Park Department of Public Safety

March 21, 2016 (Highland Park, Texas) On Tuesday April 12th, 2016, The Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., ("CALEA") will conduct a public hearing to discuss the Highland Park Department of Public Safety nomination for re-accreditation. CALEA maintains a collection of standards which have been developed by public safety practitioners, and these standards serve as a professional benchmark for public safety agencies. With regard to the delivery of public safety services, the public hearing provides the community an opportunity to give feedback to the CALEA assessors: this feedback is an important component to the accreditation process for Highland Park DPS. Since 1988, CALEA has recognized the Highland Park Department of Public Safety with professional excellence.
