Frequently asked questions:

I am disabled or have difficulty walking. Will I be able to get the vaccine?

Yes. We have golf carts to help transport people as well as wheel chairs available as needed.

I received the first dose, how do I sign up to receive the second?

If you received the vaccine at a site other than Fair Park, try to get the second dose at the same location you received the first. If you received the vaccine at Fair Park, you should come back to Fair Park on the date recommended to receive the second dose, no appointment necessary. For the Pzier vaccine, you should receive the second dose 19-23 days after the first. For the Moderna vaccine, you should receive the second dose 24-28 days after the first.

There are so many people in Dallas. Why aren't there more vaccines available?

The federal government is distributing vaccines through the State. The State then allocates vaccines to vaccine distributors across the state with the first priority being large hospital systems. Providers have to apply to be a distributor with the state. You can find a map of all vaccine distributors [here](#). You are welcome to call individual distributors to see if you can get vaccinated there as well. Much like the tests, vaccine quantities are limited now but access should increase with time.

How many doses did Dallas County receive?

Dallas County received 9,000 doses this week and 9,000 doses for next week. They have asked for even more as has the City of Dallas. Over 240,000 people have registered with the [County's distribution list](#). To aid in getting the vaccine to as many people as possible, UT Southwestern and Parkland have agreed to begin distributing the vaccine to people on the wait list.

I'm in the 1B priority group. When will I be eligible to receive the vaccine?

We will send updates as we receive them from Dallas County as when they begin to serve more people in each prioritization group.

How do I volunteer to help at Fair Park with vaccine distribution?

We are asking for your help by volunteering and/or sending others to volunteer and work the Center located at Fair Park, 3809 Grand Avenue, Dallas TX. We are trying to keep volunteers working one of two shifts as listed below. You can also come at any time and be a Runner meaning do whatever is immediately required, if anything.

Shift 1: 7:30 am - 12:45 pm

Shift 2: 12:15pm - 5:30 pm

Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older. You should dress appropriately for the potential of working outside plus wear comfortable shoes on the possibility of being on your feet most of the day.

Please feel free to sign up as many times as you want to volunteer for each week by filling out a form for that week. If you cannot make your volunteered shift(s), please reply to this email stating this. You may not receive a confirmation email so please plan on showing up as you have registered.

To enter the Fair Grounds you enter via Gate 5 (you can also take DART to the Fairgrounds) and please bring this email with you for entry onto the site. You need to park in Staff Parking or Lot 4A (turn left outside of Gate 5), an open lot next to the African American History Museum. Once parked you MUST walk to and go to the Volunteer Entry at the Tower Building, look for the signs pointing to the proper entry location. At the Volunteer Registration Area you will be checked in and assigned a location to work.

Lunch WILL be provided so please do not bring any personal items as there is no place for them to be securely stored, keep purse and other items locked in your vehicle. You also MUST be wearing a mask at ALL times. Dallas County will NOT be responsible for any lost or stolen personal property.

We also ask when you leave to PLEASE check out at the Volunteer Registration Area so that another person can be assigned to your work location.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
