



Outdoor Warning Siren Information

Monthly Siren Testing

The Town of Highland Park Department of Public Safety conducts routine testing of the Outdoor Warning Siren system on the first Wednesday of each month at 1:00 PM, weather permitting. These tests ensure the system is functioning properly and ready to alert the public in the event of an emergency.

Purpose of Outdoor Warning Sirens

Outdoor warning sirens are designed to alert people who are outdoors of potential hazards, including severe weather, hazardous material incidents, or other emergencies requiring immediate protective action. They are not intended to be heard indoors.

What To Do When You Hear a Siren

If you hear a siren outside of the scheduled monthly test, immediately seek shelter indoors and monitor trusted information sources such as local media, weather radios, or emergency alert systems.

Stay Informed

Residents are encouraged to have multiple methods of receiving emergency alerts. Outdoor sirens are only one part of the Town's emergency notification system.
